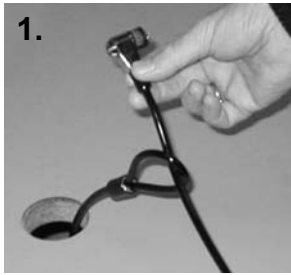

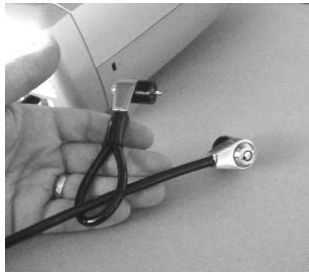

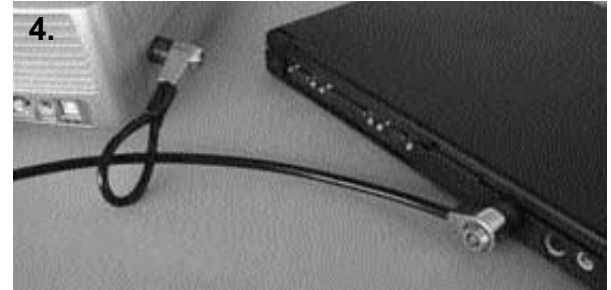
1. Lasso the Security Cable to a stationary object by passing the lock through the loop. Slip one (or more as needed) Expansion Locks over the security cable.



2. No need to use the key to engage the lock. Simply insert the locking mechanism into the security slot on the equipment; push the button until it “clicks” into the locked position. You may hear a soft click as the lock engages.



3. A SNUG FIT IS MORE SECURE. If lock feels loose once engaged, use key to remove lock and attach one or more of the enclosed spacers to the bumper. Reinsert into security slot and push button.



4. In the photo above, the Expansion Lock was added to secure a projector and a laptop to a single Notebook Guardian laptop anti-theft security cable.
